Role Title:	Sports Union Intramural Sport Officer
Responsible to:	Sports Union Vice President Intramural Sport / Sports Union Intramural Sport Coordinator
Requirements to run:	Must be a Member of the Intramural Sport programme.
Recommended skills / experience:	Evidence of previous involvement with Intramural Sport.
	Be a pro-active, and enthusiastic, individual who has the ability to work unsupervised and as part of a team.
	Ideally candidates will have been an IMS team Captain, Club Rec Officer or Society Sports Secretary.
	Knowledge of fixture scheduling.
	Strong Computing and IT skills, as well as excellent attention to detail.
	Excellent communication, organisational and planning skills.
Responsibilities:	Sitting on the Intramural Sport Committee; contributing to policies, solving problems and helping to develop the programme.
	Collaborating with the Sports Coordinator and Executives on the review of procedures and rules of their intramural sport for the year.
	Assisting with the Intramural Sport stand at the Sports Fair if required.
	Acting as a representative and communication link between team captains and the Sports Union.
	Looking to increase participation through signposting.
	Collecting content from their sport, to increase publicity.
	Offering advice to team captains who may be struggling with organisation.
Time commitment:	Approx. 1 hour per academic week
	Be able to attend various Sports Union meetings throughout the year.
