Dedication to the improvement of the University's sporting offer. **Key responsibilities:** Organise the activities of the International Sports Club Support clubs in hosting recreational sessions Work with the Active Lives team to grow participation projects Deliver participation-focussed events through the academic year **Time commitment:** 6-8 hours per academic week.
